# What Type of Testing Is Included?

Heart disease is the #1 killer in the nation, followed by cancer, stroke, and diabetes. Preventative screening saves lives. Routine health screening can ensure that common serious diseases and conditions are detected.

The health screening tests the following:

- COMPREHENSIVE METABOLIC PANEL (CMP)
   This panel gives your doctor important information about the current status of your kidneys, liver, electrolyte, and acid balance as well as your blood sugar and blood protein levels.
- LIPID PROFILE
   Measures cholesterol, triglycerides, HDL
   and LDL
- COMPLETE BLOOD COUNT (CBC)
   Screens for anemia, infection, and many other diseases.
- THYROID STIMULATING HORMONE (TSH) Screens for hyperthyroidism or hypothyroidism by evaluating thyroid function.
- URIC ACID
   This test is used to screen for gout.
- PROSTATE CANCER SCREENING (men only)
